His main areas of clinical and research interests include: Major Trauma, management of spinal cord injury, Sub Arachnoid Haemorrhage, optimising critical care outcome and rehabilitation and recovery from critical illness. He also has an interest in organ donation and was the National Clinical lead for organ donation from 2006 to 2010 having a key role in introducing non heart beating organ donation across the UK.

He established HDU facilities for the North of England Spinal Injuries unit in 2000 and helped to establish the undergraduate curriculum at University of Durham and is still currently CD in critical care at South Tees (since 2006) and clearly going for some sort of record!
